- New Study: Teacher Compensation in Emergency Contexts: Mapping of Donor Practices and Perspectives (Primary Investigator; funded by Education International)
- This study seeks to examine the approaches and perspectives of key bilateral and multilateral donors regarding the support of teacher compensation in crisis-affected contexts over the past two decades, with a focus on the challenges and disparities in teacher remuneration across different teacher profiles (e.g. national, refugee, etc.). Additionally, the study will assess the potential advantages and drawbacks of a proposed global fund aimed at ensuring timely, regular and adequate salary payments for teachers working in vulnerable, crisis-affected settings, while also considering the increasing role of families and communities in addressing these gaps.
